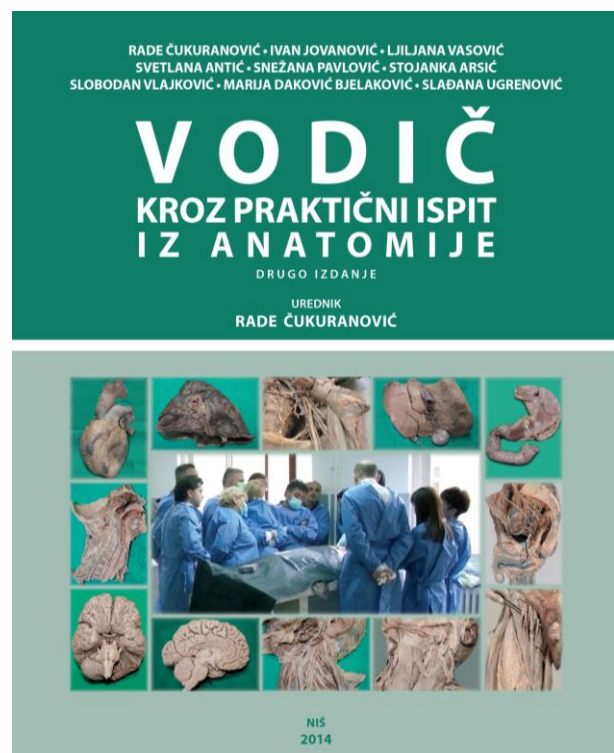

..All anatomical preparations come from human cadaveric material processed and prepared observing the most rigorous anatomical principles, demonstrating very clearly all the structures within respective regions, being equal in that regard with similar publications in the international literature. The organs also come from cadaveric material, being processed anatomically in a way that the details intended are clearly visible... The approach, processing procedures, and photographs are unique in our region and, I believe, in nearby countries as well, since there is no similar publication for practical instruction in anatomy, and it will be a useful supplemental tool to be used by the students of medicine and other related disciplines for exam preparation.
